How do you listen with the ear of your heart?

This full-day workshop is built around Paul's Letter to the Romans. It's designed specifically for those who wrestle with the dynamic word of God we call the Bible. Participants will gain tools that support learning how to listen with the ear of the heart when reading, studying, or meditating on Sacred Scripture. This experience can be vastly different than listening with the ear of our wounds. The workshop can be a powerful step towards healing them. Those who have been wounded by Christianity and are on their own healing journey into God and those looking to deepen their relationship with God will find this workshop particularly helpful.

The workshop opens with laying a foundation for using our own incarnation experience to listen with the ear of our heart. Instruction and practice of contemplative tools grounded in Tradition build on this foundation. We will eat lunch together in community and experience Paul's Letter to the Romans, again using these contemplative tools. After our meal experience, prayer, meditation, and supportive group discussion will allow for integration of new insights gained through the Romans Experience.
